Xavier General Management Aptitude Test (X-GMT) is an online entrance test being conducted by Xavier University for the following Degree Programs as follows:

- o MBA in Business Management (BBA)
- o MBA in Global Management (GMA)
- o Executive MBA in Business Management (EMBA-BM)
- o Executive MBA in Business Analytics (EMBA-BA)
- o MBA in Human Resource Management (HRMA)
- o MBA in Rural Management (RMA)
- o MBA in Sustainability Management (SMA)
- o MBA in Urban Management & Governance (UMBA)
- o Master of Business Finance (MBF)

Eligibility for attempting X-GMT 2019: Candidates should have completed (or) minimum 3-year duration in any discipline from a recognized university with at least 55% of marks in aggregate (60% for MBF). Candidates who expect to complete the final part of their degree examinations by June 15, 2019, may also apply.

Pattern of X-GMT 2019

X-GMT 2019 will be a computer based online test. The duration of the exam will be 120 minutes in the medium of the test in English for all the candidates. Candidates need to attempt multiple choice questions (MCQs) that will be spread across Quantitative Aptitude (QA), Verbal & Logical Reasoning (VA & LR), Data Interpretation (DI), Emotional Quotient and General Awareness (EQ & GA). The four sections during the test will appear in random sequence and there will be section time limits, which means a candidate must complete a section in a given time. If a candidate finishes a section before the time limit, the candidate can move to the next section. The type and nature of questions will be like the other prominent entrance tests for management education. There will be negative marks for incorrect answers.
